

Leading Education is the only provider to offer a summer programme from which students can gain this valuable qualification, worth UCAS points, in just four weeks.

Students need to be independent and motivated as considerable time is spent researching and writing an academic paper. Running alongside the University Subject Exploration programme, students will share activities and excursions.

#### What is an EPQ?

The EPQ is a research-based qualification that can be completed as either a 5,000 word dissertation, or an artefact or performance with an accompanying dissertation.

## What do I get at the end of it?

Leading Education mentors and the course leader will guide students through multiple drafts. After students have graduated they will be emailed with their grade and the qualification once it is validated by an exam centre.









#### Why is it important?

An EPQ is highly regarded by universities all over the world. In the UK, Oxford & Cambridge specifically refer to it as a very positive thing to include in personal statements and discuss in interviews.

Some universities will lower their required grades in an offer if they see a student has already completed an EPQ; and lower-ranked universities will count the EPQ towards any UCAS Tariff requirements in the offer (an A\* in an EPQ is worth 28 UCAS Tariff points).

# How is it different to other summer programmes?

The Leading Education EPQ Boot
Camp is unique in offering an A-Level
equivalent qualification at the end of it.
Students must be prepared for a very
different model of tuition to a traditional
academic summer school. They will
be required to work in small groups in
supervised study sessions, with only
small amounts of direct tuition.

#### **Academic Content**

- 70+ hours of direct and supervised study time over four weeks
- Workshops on academic research and writing at university level

#### What else is included?

## How long is the programme?

Students arrive on 30th June. Those who stay for 27 nights until Saturday 28th July will be awarded the qualification. Students who only stay for 13 nights will not be awarded the full qualification but can choose to book an additional 10 hours of online 1:1 tuition after the return home to complete the course. Please enquire for further details. Students may also combine the EPQ Boot Camp with 2 weeks of University Subject Exploration.

Unlike other summer schools, Leading Education courses are not just for summer! With over 400 fantastic, Oxbridge-educated tutors working with us all year round – helping students with their studies and university applications – Leading Education will provide extra online classes for every student who attends one of our summer courses in person.

All students will receive online introductory classes and pre-arrival information from tutors as well as the following for each programme:

## English Summer Immersion

- 4 × 45 minute group EFL classes (one every 3 months), building on summer learning
- Optional 1:1 specialist consultation with a Higher Education specialist for any student interested in studying at a UK school or university

## University Subject Exploration

- 4 × 45 minute small-group classes (one every 3 months) in one chosen USE subject, building on summer learnings
- A 1:1 specialist consultant with a Higher Education specialist, working on personal statements, interviews, and general application strategy

### **EPQ** Boot Camp

- We find that most students attending for 4 weeks need 3-4 extra online sessions to complete the EPQ. These 1:1 sessions with their summer tutor will be included in the cost
- Extra lessons for any student attending for 2 weeks in summer will be offered at a discounted rate (we recommend a further 10 hours could be needed)

PLEASE NOTE: students must register for the EPQ by October and the final essay must be submitted by 1st November to allow Leading Education to grade and submit for a grade to be awarded in January.



## Safeguarding & Wellbeing

All Leading Education summer staff will have received extensive Safeguarding training with the Centre Manager appointed as the Safeguarding lead. Staff will be on-site at all times and available 24 hours a day for any student concerns or questions.
